

MDM Syndicator – Merging Fields from External Tables

Summary

This article provides a step-by-step procedure in manually syndicate the records (merge fields from external table into the current repository table, to create virtual extended Source records) to a Remote System in Flat file format.

Business Scenario

Let's take an example, the source data to be syndicated may not all belong to a table in the connected MDM Repository. In this case, there must be a way to first join tables together and then merge fields from the external table, to create virtual extended source records (containing both current table fields and external table fields) for syndication.

The Merge Item feature of the MDM Syndicator enables fields from tables outside of the connected MDM repository to be added as source items for syndication, eliminating the need for additional, repetitive work in order to export data from external tables. Once source fields and destination fields are mapped, the MDM Syndicator adds data to the syndication file in one of two ways, depending upon the syndication format.

1. On Flat text syndications.
2. On XML syndications.

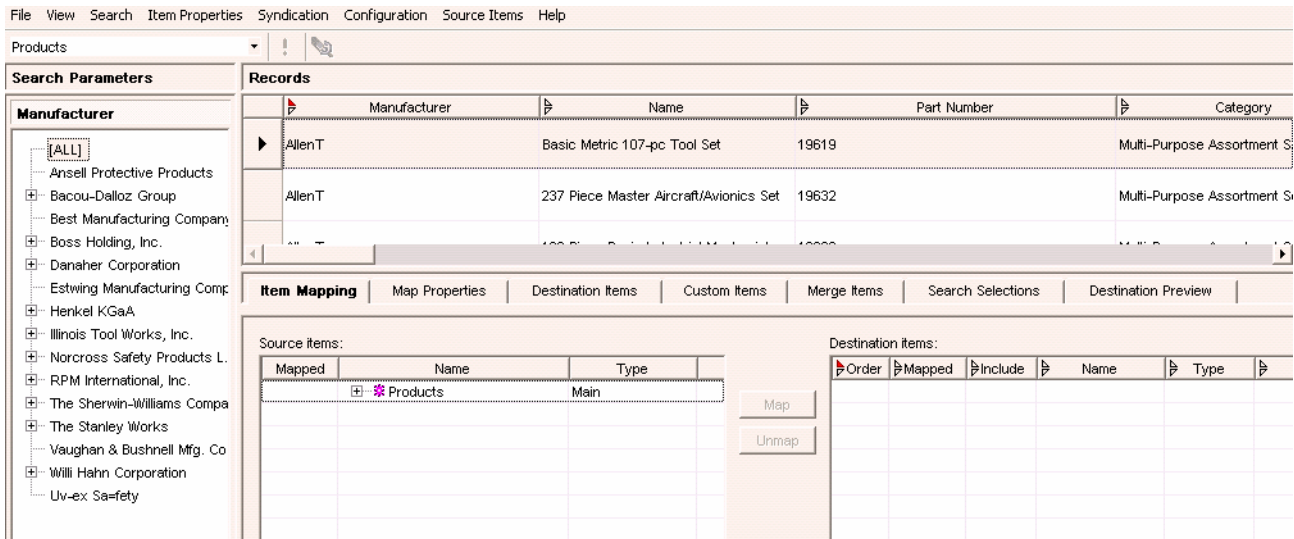
To achieve this, first launch MDM syndicator, set the Map properties and then select the destination properties. Add Merge items, Destination items and Map the source items to destination items and Execute the Syndication action.

Syndication Process Flow Overview

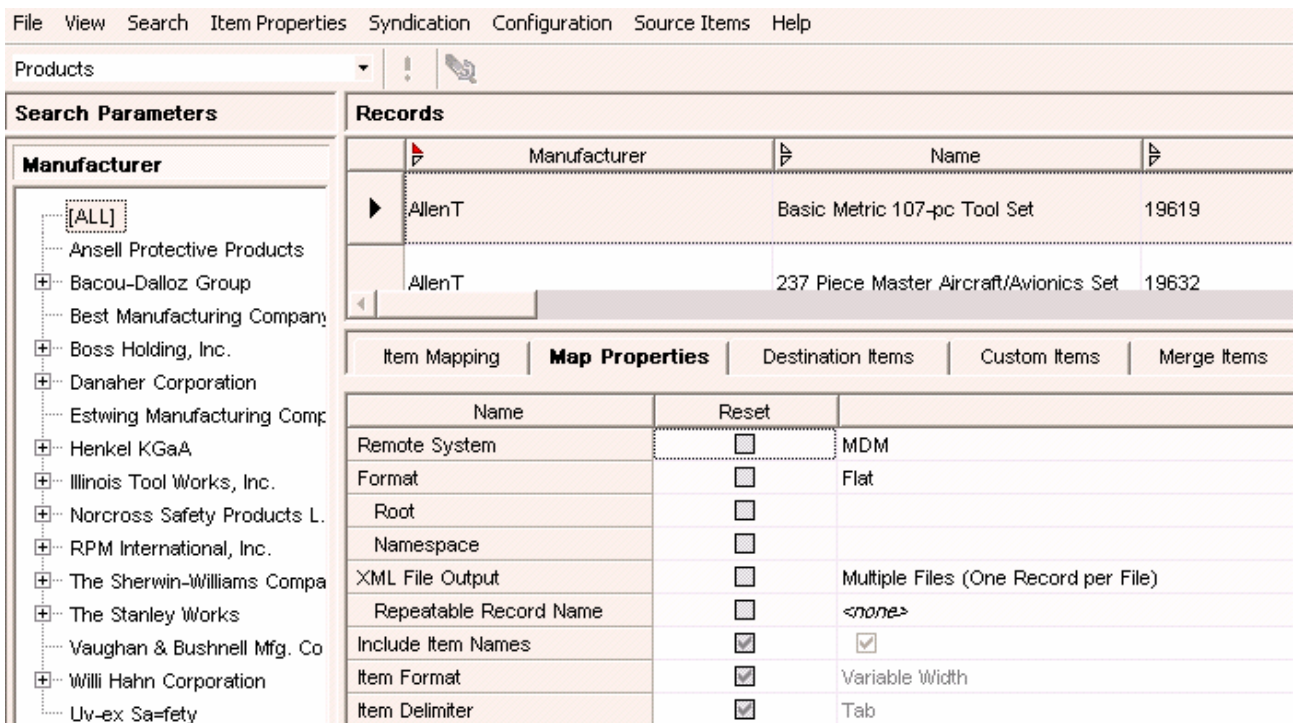
1. Launch MDM Syndicator.
2. Set the Map properties.
3. Select Destination Properties.
4. Add Merge Items
5. Add Destination Items.
6. Map Source items and Destination items.
7. Execute the Syndication action.

MDM Syndicator Steps

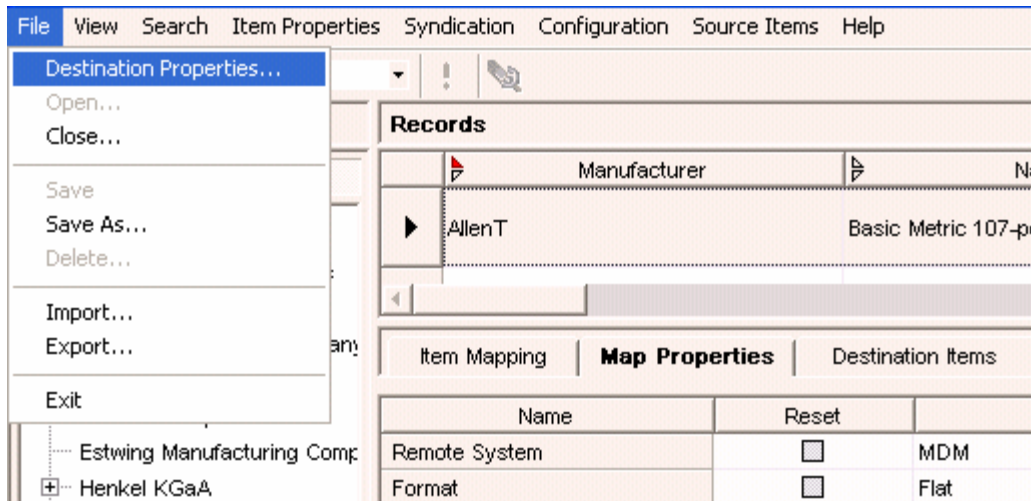
1. Launch the MDM Syndicator application from your Windows desktop. You should see:



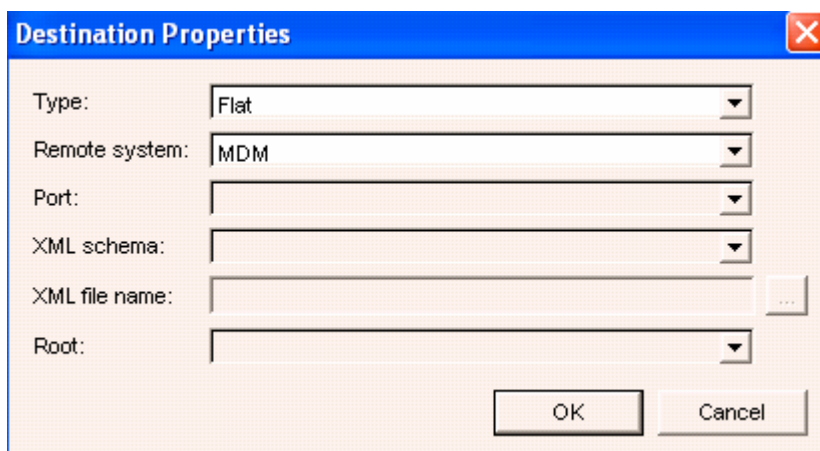
2. Press the Map Properties tab, you should see:



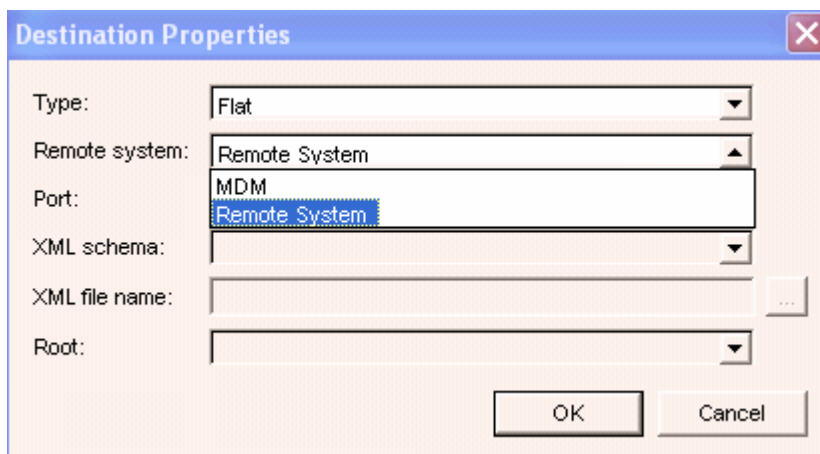
3. Click on file in the Menu bar, and select Destination Properties:



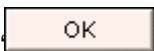



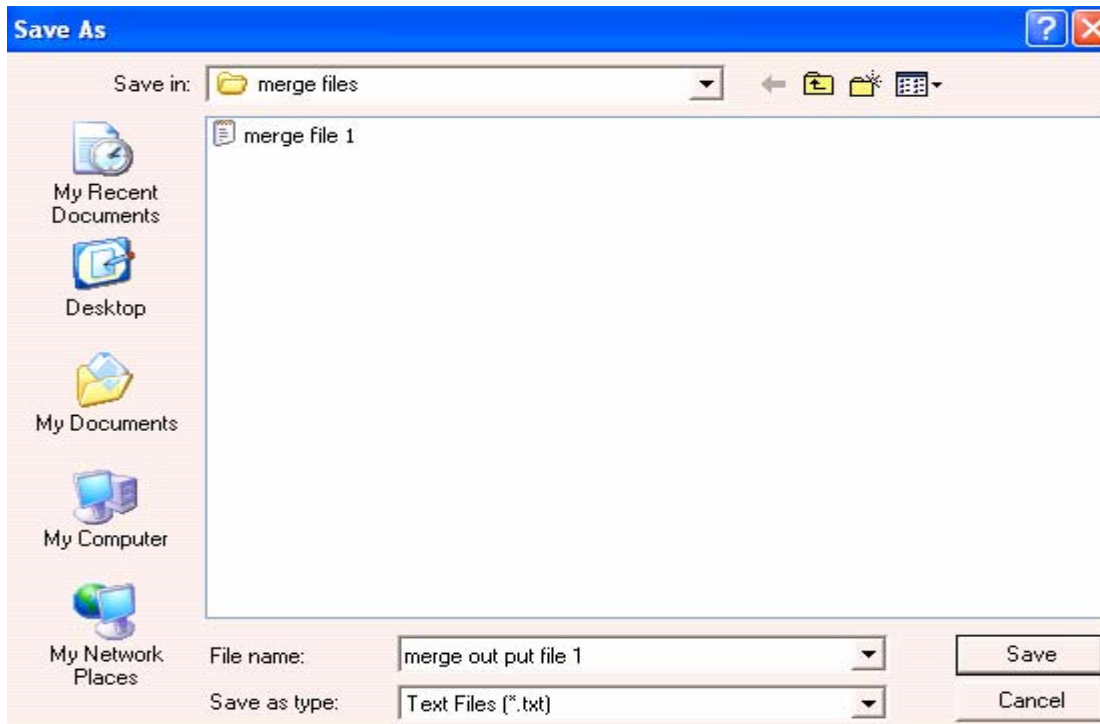

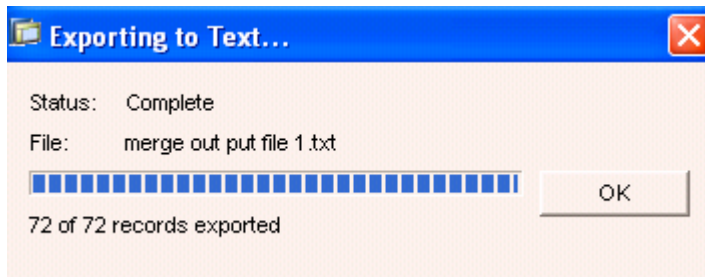
