
How to Create a Journal Entry With Different Currencies?

It is an occasional requirement to create manual journal entries with multiple currencies, yet when the accountant attempts to do so, the following error message is received:


Transaction includes more than one currency [Message 173-17]

SAP Business One can be set up to allow the entry of multiple currencies into a journal entry (JE) if the following applies:


1. Under Administration -> System Initialisation -> Document Settings -> Per Document tab page -> Block Multi-Currency Journal Entry check box is unchecked.



2. While standing on JE, call up the Form Settings and go to Document tab page -> General tab page -> Allow Multi-Currency Transactions. Ascertain that the check box is ticked:



You will now be able to enter a journal entry with multiple currencies, for example:



Please note that since multiple currencies are present in the Debit (FC) and Credit (FC) columns, the summary field at the bottom of the table will contain '***'.
