

#### How to update stock quantities according to a previous date?

#### Note 731051

In order to make an update according to a certain date, perform the following:

1. Click the 'Inventory Posting' tab page under Stock Management -> Stock Transactions -> Initial Quantities, Stock Tracking and Stock Posting. Select the 'Stock Posting' tab.




- 2. Enter the required selection criteria and click on 'OK'.
- 3. In the resulting 'Stock Posting' window, change the date to the required backdated one in the 'Date' field. In the 'Details' field record the reason for this transaction.



4. Enter the difference between the displayed stock level in the warehouse and the actual stock level counted on that day. Click on 'Update Quantities'.



5. Once the quantities have been updated, the actually counted quantity appears in the 'Counted' column and the 'Price' column is grayed out.



6. In order to complete the update and record the actual quantity in SAP Business One, click the 'Reconcile' button.

We highly recommend exporting these values to MS Excel to create a record of the details of the transaction before reconciling since the data in this window will not be available again.
