

# MDM Syndicator – Tracking New & Changed Records

SAP NetWeaver Master Data Management (MDM) SP3, SP4, SP5.

This article provides a step-by-step procedure in manually syndicate the records (recently added or changed and select those for syndication) to a Remote System in Flat file format.

## Business Scenario

Let's take an example: To keep your remote systems populated with "fresh" data, the two options used to be: (1) syndicate all records, all of the time or, (2) find a way to identify only the records that have been recently added or changed and select those for syndication. Either option carries a cost in bandwidth or workload.

The MDM Syndicator offers a Suppress Unchanged Records option which tracks whether or not a record has changed since the last time it was syndicated to a particular remote system. If the record has not changed, the Syndicator automatically excludes it from the set of records to be syndicated. If the record is new, it will be added to the set of records to be syndicated. Using this feature, you can keep data in all your remote systems "fresh" without overburdening any of your networks or applications with unnecessary record traffic.

When the Suppress Unchanged Records map property is enabled on a map, the Syndicator uses this timestamp to determine whether a record has changed since its last syndication to that map's remote system. If it has changed, the record is included in the syndication file. If it has not changed, the record is suppressed. In order for the Syndicator to keep track of record timestamps, the current table's Key Mapping property must be set to Yes on the MDM Console.

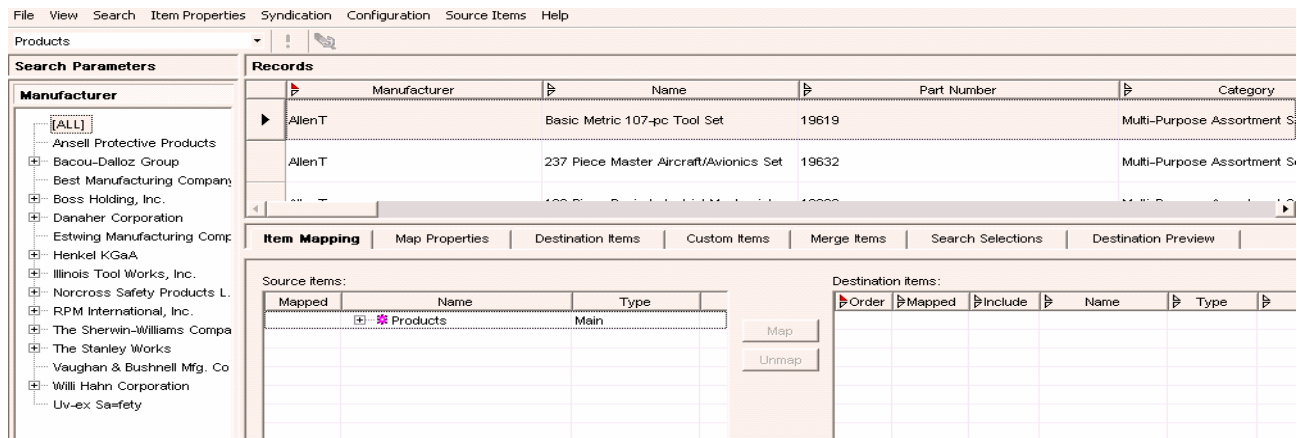
To achieve this, first launch MDM syndicator, set the Map properties (enable Suppress Unchanged Records property) and then select the destination properties. Once source fields and destination fields are mapped, the MDM Syndicator adds data to the syndication file in one of two ways, depending upon the syndication format. 1. On Flat text syndications. 2. On XML syndications. Execute the Syndication action.

## Syndication Process Flow Overview

1. Launch MDM Syndicator.
2. Set the Map properties.
3. Select Destination Properties.
4. Add Destination Items.
5. Map Source items and Destination items.
6. Execute the Syndication action.

## MDM Syndicator Steps

1. Launch the MDM Syndicator application from your Windows desktop. You should see:

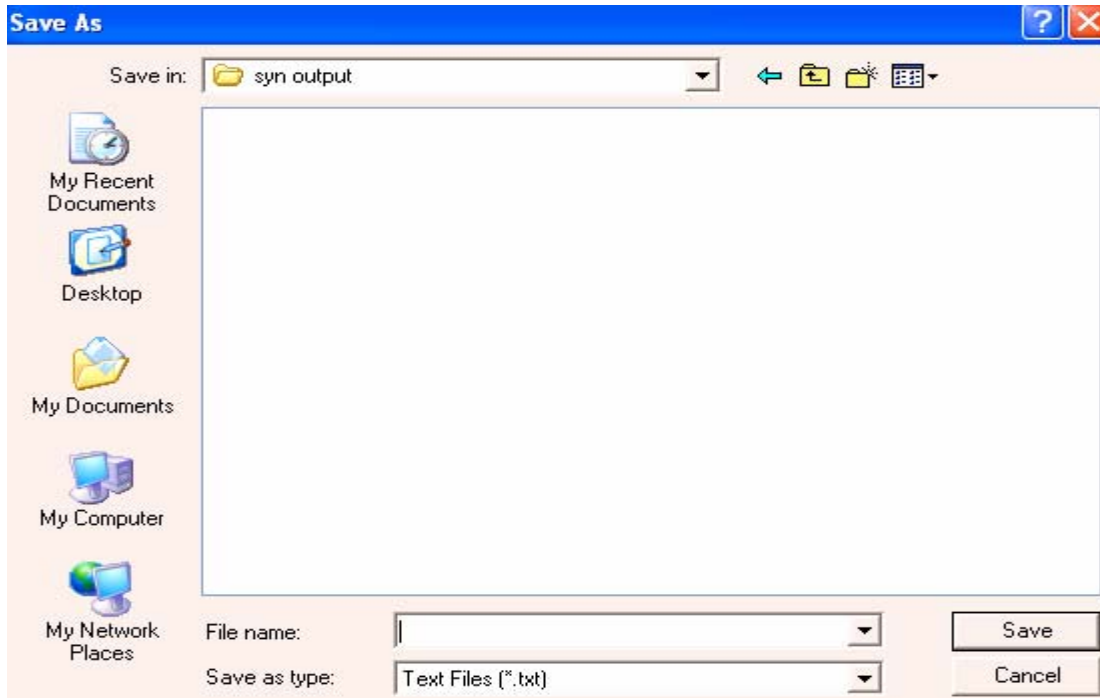

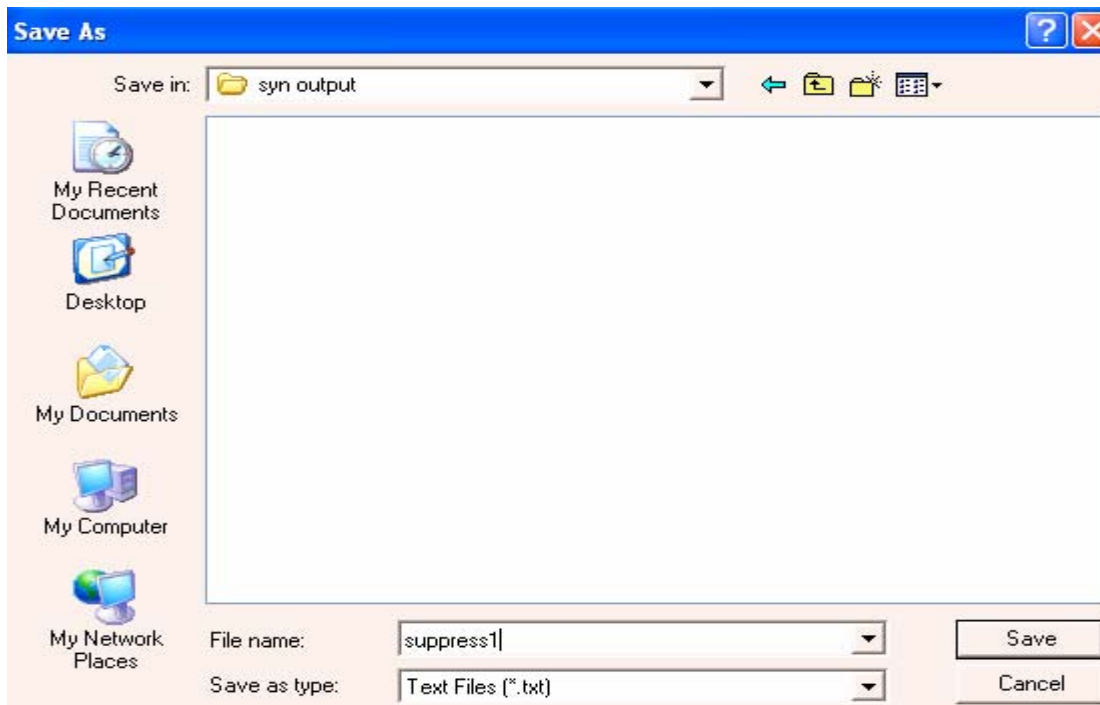

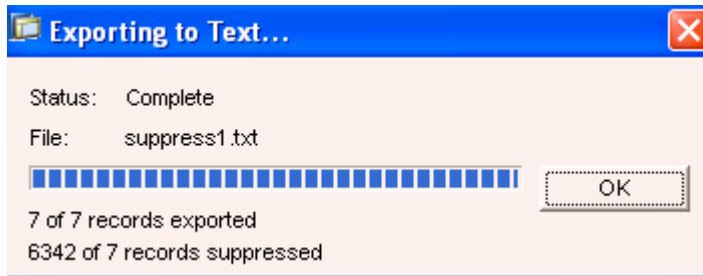
