SAP NetWeaver Identity Management is based on the proven technology of MaXware, a company recently acquired by SAP. This solution reduces the complexity and cost associated with managing identities (users), permissions and passwords. The software helps SAP's customers to integrate business processes and is designed to work not only with SAP applications but with all of the systems, instances, and applications in a typical, heterogeneous and often global IT environment. SAP's identity management solution is also designed to work as an integrated component of your strategic application platform and to support an enterprise service oriented architecture (enterprise SOA).

The new SP1 version of SAP NetWeaver Identity Management 7.0 eases implementation by providing templates for backend connectivity and is available at <http://www.service.sap.com/swdc> (You must follow the path --> Download --> Installations and Upgrades --> Entry by Application Group --> SAP NetWeaver --> SAP NW Identity Management --> SAP NW Identity Management 7.0 --> "Installation" in order to find the downloadable ZIP-files).
