TERP10 Faculty Certification course

The TERP10 course is an official SAP Certification course for faculty that wish to incorporate an SAP Certification into university courses. The course lasts 10 days and is divided over two one week sessions with a Certification exam taking place on the final day. Upon completion of the exam and achieving a passing grade faculty achieve a full SAP Certification and are entitled to teach that Certification to students. The course is open to any faculty that have taken the SAP Introductory course or in exceptional circumstances can show a prior experience of SAP.

SAP Introductory Workshop

The SAP Introductory Workshops are for faculty that are beginning to use the software for the first time and want to understand the fundamentals of using SAP, or that would like a refresher before commencing teaching. The course lasts 5 days and upon completion gives faculty a very rounded set of SAP skills as well as teaching materials and cases that can be immediately deployed. The course is open to any UA member from around the world.
