

Quick View Insider—Microblog: I Don't Want Certain Partner Users to Add Attachments, Add URLs, Send E-Mails, Or Ask for Response!

Summary

This article explains how you deactivate these options by clearing the corresponding flags in method /SCF/IF_MYSTALK_PERMISSION~GET_PERMISSIONS of the microblog's feeder class.

You can also hide the corresponding UI elements in WebDynpro's administration mode – for that option, please refer to article *How Do I Disallow Personalization* (Options 2 and 3).

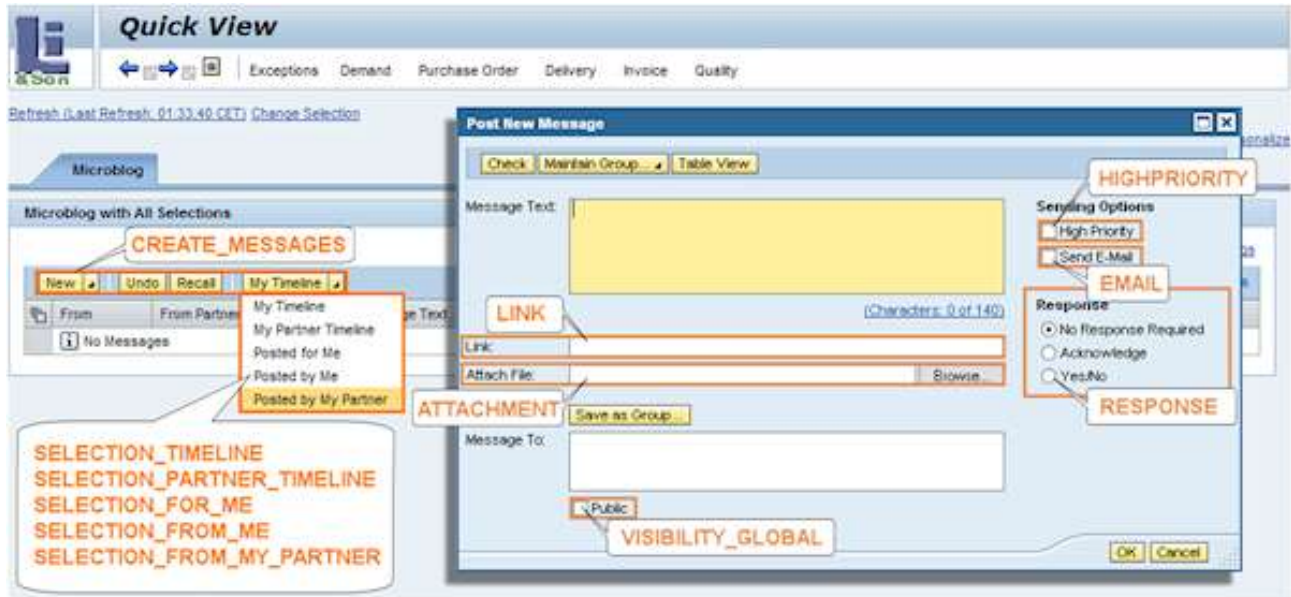

The microblog's building block's feeder class controls what the user can do with microblog. You can also leave this feeder class empty. A microblog without feeder class will only allow users to read microblog messages. Users will not be able to create any messages, therefore the only view available to them is the "Posted for Me" view (compare article *Why Is There No Inbox?*).

You can control the following microblog features with the feeder class (compare structure /SCF/TMSG_UI_PERMISSION_STR):



In addition to the flags listed in the screen shots, flag GLOBAL_EMAIL controls the combination of checkbox *Public* and checkbox *Send E-Mail*: If both checkboxes are selected and GLOBAL_EMAIL is set, the system sends out an e-mail to any user in the system that has an e-mail address. This could be many e-mails, so by default this option is OFF.
